BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 342F-30.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending its title and subsection (a) to read:
- 4 "[+]\$342F-30.8[+] Leaf blowers; weed whackers;
- 5 restrictions. (a) In any urban land use district, as
- 6 designated pursuant to section 205-2, it shall be unlawful for
- 7 any person to operate a leaf blower or weed whacker within a
- 8 residential zone or within one hundred feet of a residential
- 9 zone in the State, except between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and
- 10 [6:00] 7:00 p.m. on any day except Sunday or a state or federal
- 11 holiday, and between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and [6:00] 7:00 p.m.
- 12 on Sunday or any state or federal holiday."
- 2. By amending subsections (d) and (e) to read:
- "(d) Any county may adopt a rule or ordinance that places
- 15 stricter limitations on the use of leaf blowers or weed whackers
- 16 than are in this section. In case of a conflict between the
- 17 requirements or limitations of this section and any county rule

- 1 or ordinance regarding the use of leaf blowers $[\tau]$ or weed
- 2 whackers, the more restrictive requirements shall apply.
- 3 (e) For the purposes of this section:
- 4 "Leaf blower" means any machine used to blow leaves, dirt,
- 5 or other debris off sidewalks, driveways, lawns, and other
- 6 surfaces.
- 7 "State holiday" means any day established as a state
- 8 holiday in section 8-1.
- 9 "Weed whacker" means a gasoline or electric powered yard
- 10 tool that uses either a flexible monofilament line (also known
- 11 as a string or line trimmer) or revolving metal cutting blade
- 12 intended to cut or trim grass and other vegetation."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on
- 16 December 31, 2050.

Makes it unlawful for any non-government entity or agent thereof to operate a weed whacker in or within one hundred feet of a residential zone, except between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on most days. Defines weed whacker. Takes effect 12/31/2050. (SD1)
