A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-355, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as
3 follows:

4 "~~{}~~§11-355~~{}~~ **Contributions by state and county**
5 **contractors prohibited.** (a) It shall be unlawful for any
6 person who enters into any contract with the State, any of the
7 counties, or any department or agency thereof either for the
8 rendition of personal services, the buying of property, or
9 furnishing of any material, supplies, or equipment to the State,
10 any of the counties, any department or agency thereof, or for
11 selling any land or building to the State, any of the counties,
12 or any department or agency thereof, if payment for the
13 performance of the contract or payment for material, supplies,
14 equipment, land, property, or building is to be made in whole or
15 in part from funds appropriated by the legislative body, at any
16 time between the execution of the contract through the
17 completion of the contract, to:



- 1 (1) Directly or indirectly make any contribution, or
- 2 promise expressly or impliedly to make any
- 3 contribution to any candidate committee or
- 4 noncandidate committee, or to any candidate or to any
- 5 person for any political purpose or use; [~~or~~]
- 6 (2) Knowingly solicit any contribution from any person for
- 7 any purpose during any period[~~or~~]; or
- 8 (3) Directly or indirectly participate in political
- 9 election campaign activities, including canvassing,
- 10 sign holding, and other volunteer support for a
- 11 candidate or noncandidate committee."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
