SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO AMEND THE HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE RULES TO AUTHORIZE LICENSED DIETITIANS TO PRESCRIBE MODIFIED DIETS AND PLAN THERAPEUTIC DIETS.

1 WHEREAS, Hawaii has repeatedly and consistently been 2 recognized by the federal government as a health professional shortage area; and 3 4 WHEREAS, registered dietitian nutritionists (RDNs) enhance 5 patient care by providing key nutrition services, and is 6 recognized widely by physicians as the most gualified health 7 care professionals to help patients with diet-related 8 conditions; and 9 10 WHEREAS, in 2014, the federal Centers for Medicare and 11 Medicaid Services (CMS) announced a final rule allowing RDNs in 12 hospital settings to be privileged to independently write diet 13 orders without the supervision or approval of the physician, on 14 the basis that it would: 15 16 17 (1)Reduce unnecessary and burdensome procedures by physicians to write the diet orders; 18 19 20 (2) Increase flexibility for health care providers to 21 improve care; 22 23 (3) Reduce costs to each health care facility; and 24 25 Allow primary care physicians to focus on their (4) 26 respective areas of expertise to care for patients; 27 and 28 29 WHEREAS, the CMS rules deferred to each individual hospital system the determination of whether to grant RDNs specific 30 31 nutrition order-writing privileges to suit each hospital 32 system's needs, within the confines of state regulations; and 33

WHEREAS, the existing Hawaii Administrative Rules do not 1 allow licensed dietitians to issue diet orders; and 2 3 WHEREAS, allowing licensed dietitians to prescribe and plan 4 diets within the State's health care system will reduce issues 5 associated with the current shortage of physicians in the State, 6 while ensuring that patients have sufficient nutrition; now, 7 8 therefore, 9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 10 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 11 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 12 Health is urged to amend the Hawaii Revised Statutes to 13 authorize licensed dietitians to prescribe modified diets and 14 plan therapeutic diets; specifically, by amending section 15 11-93-8, subsections (c) and (d), Hawaii Administrative Rules, 16 to read as follows: 17 18 "(c) All modified diets shall be: 19 20 Prescribed by the patient's physician or 21 (1)qualified dietitian privileged by the hospital to 22 do so with a record of the diet as ordered kept 23 on file. 24 25 (2)Planned, prepared, and served by qualified 26 27 personnel using the current Hawaii Dietetic Association manual or the American Dietetic 28 Association manual, or both. 29 30 (3) Reviewed and adjusted as needed. 31 32 33 (d) Therapeutic diets shall be planned by a [qualified] licensed dietitian, as prescribed by the patient's 34 physician[-] or licensed dietitian privileged by the 35 hospital to do so. Nutrition assessment and dietary 36 counseling shall be provided by a dietitian when indicated 37 for a patient. Nutrition plans and follow-ups shall be 38 documented in the individual medical record."; and 39 40 41
